Thomas G. Bognanno is an influential nonprofit leader with over 40 years of experience leading nonprofit, corporate social responsibility (CSR) and health initiatives. Now a founder and managing partner with Alliance Practice Ltd, Tom recently retired as President and CEO of CHC: Creating Healthier Communities in April, 2023 after seventeen years at the helm for that organization. Prior to that, Tom had a distinguished 20-year career with the American Diabetes Association (ADA), serving as Chief Field Officer when he left that organization. Prior to ADA, he spent six years with the American Cancer Society.

Tom was instrumental in revitalizing the community-level infrastructure of ADA and prioritizing volunteer and staff development. He was also one of the chief architects of the Everyday Choices for a Healthier Life partnership with the ADA, the American Heart Association, and the American Cancer Society.

At CHC: Creating Healthier Communities, Tom led the organization in its ever-expanding and evolving commitment to building healthier communities and health equity. For more than 65 years, CHC has worked together with partners—nonprofit, corporate, government and beyond—to address the barriers to good health and equity and create resilient communities where everyone can thrive. CHC’s role is to enhance the capacity of nonprofit organizations, connect and convene diverse stakeholders, and harness collective resources and programs to activate collaborations that improve the health of our communities. In his tenure at CHC, Tom significantly increased the organization’s focus on the social and political drivers of health, the underlying factors that affect overall wellbeing.

Tom currently serves as Board Chair for ZERO Prostate Cancer, the nation’s leading nonprofit organization fighting prostate cancer. He also chairs the nationwide Prostate Cancer Patient Advisory Board and serves as member of the Pfizer Prostate Cancer Patient Centricity Steering Committee. Additionally, he serves as Secretary for the Board of Directors for the Institute for Sustainable Development.

Residing in northern Virginia, Tom and his wife, Suzan, have been married for 43 years and raised three children.
